

COVID-19 – information for suppliers

Urenco takes its commitments to the safety of all our colleagues, partners and stakeholders seriously. As a result of the recent outbreak of the COVID-19 virus we are implementing a series of measures to enhance protection of our assets. These will have an impact on the way we work with our suppliers.

General

1. All contractors with significant personnel interactions on site shall ensure that they have sufficiently vetted any personnel who will be visiting a Urenco site, and have an ongoing program to vet future travellers to minimize the chance of transmission of the COVID-19 virus to on-site personnel. Suppliers should continue to monitor World Health Organisation and local Governmental information sources to ensure they remain compliant with our requirements.
2. Meetings at site should be kept to a minimum and only where considered essential will face to face meetings be arranged. Suppliers are advised to expect to have to participate in an increased number of Conference Calls/Webex/Video Conferences to maintain communications with Urenco.
3. At present we do not anticipate any change to our operational demands. You should continue to plan to deliver products to us as per our contractual arrangements. We are monitoring the situation carefully and will advise of any change to our requirements through the normal channels.

Attendance at Urenco Sites

Restrictions will be placed on contractors accessing/visiting Urenco sites who have recently travelled to an Affected Area and will be confirmed by Procurement prior to on-site arrival. Urenco is adopting the World Health Organisation (WHO) definition of affected areas as those “countries, provinces, territories or cities experiencing ongoing transmission of COVID-19, in contrast to areas reporting only imported cases”. Definitions and advice on this can be found at [WHO International Travel Advice](#). This definition is supplemented and updated by the following local interpretations:

UUSA (Including Arlington Office)	Contractor/Supplier Staff who have visited Level 2 and Level 3 countries in the past 14 days are not allowed on site. Designation of Country Levels can be found here . Personnel who have been to an affected area by WHO's definition (with the additional direction as provided by the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention on specific states defined here who also exhibit flu-like symptoms will not be allowed on site.)
Urenco Nederland	Contractor/Supplier Staff should not attend site if they have travelled to any area listed here within the last 14 days.
Urenco Deutschland	Contractor/Supplier Staff should not attend site if they have been in a High Risk Area, defined here , within the last 14 days.
Urenco UK (Including Head Office)	Contractor/Supplier Staff should not attend site if they have been in a Category 1 Country within the last 14 days. Staff should not attend site if they have been in a Category 2 country and are displaying signs of illness/flu like symptoms. Country Categorisation can be found here .

Suppliers should monitor these sites and reports on a regular basis to determine if employees have been travelling within an Affected Area as part of ongoing management of the situation. Although there are no cases of coronavirus within Urenco, our actions are designed to mitigate this risk.
