The Weekendschool, founded in 2008, gives children (aged 10 to 14) from diverse backgrounds the opportunity to broaden their horizons educationally, socio-culturally and socially in order to positively influence their prospects for the future.

Specifically our partnership will fund a dedicated project manager for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Maths) subjects, develop the curriculum and expand the programme with three additional groups. Further, Urenco will add to their growing alumni programme by offering master classes and traineeships.

There are currently 12 groups in the Almelo region, supporting around 250 young people per school year. The students attend weekend meetings, covering various fields of expertise and hear from a variety of professions and organisations.
